WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto SECURITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, GREENVILLE, S. NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of being near the city of Green-ville, known and designated as Lot No. 11 of a subdivsion known as Staunton Court, as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, dated June 1966, revised April 1967 recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book PPP at page 143, and having the said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northeast side of Staunton Court, the joint front corner of Lots Nos. IO and ll; thence with the joint line of said lots N. 58-12 E. 110.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-55 W. 150.08 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 12; thence with the line of said lot S. 58-19 W. 110.65 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Staunton Court; thence with the northeast side of said street S. 31-48 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
