"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the state of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fountain Inn Township, being a portion of the Mittle E. Jones Property and shown as Lot 1 on plat of property entitled Garrett and Garrett dated April 10, 1961, made by R. B. Bruce and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeastern side of Main Street, also referred to as U. S.
