"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northwest side of Seabrook Court, being shown as Lot 1 on plat of Section E of Gower Estates, made by R. K. Campbell and Webb Surveying & Mapping Co., October 1964, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BBB at page 71, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point at the southern corner of Lots 1 and 2 and running thence along Lot 2, N 27-18 W 330.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S 24-52 W 184.5 feet to a point in the center of a branch; thence along the center of said branch, the traverse lines being as follows: S 47-22 W 210 feet and S 10-22 W 200.4 feet to a point in the center of said branch; thence N 62-56 E 470 feet to the beginning corner.
