All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Town of

Mauldin, being known and designated as Lot No. 55 on a plat of Peachtree Terrace Subdivision recorded in Plat Book EE at Page 189 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
