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rogetions with all region, interests, examinating interests and apputenances thereunts obsinging, the tents, issues, and profits thereof and revenues and income therefore, all improvements and personal property one or later attended thereto or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, all water, water rights, and water stock persisining thereto, and all payments at any time owing to florower by virtue of any sale, lease, transfer, conveyance, or condemnation of any part thereof or interest thereto—all of which are herein called "the property";

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever.

BORROWER for himself, his helrs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRANTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easemonts, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinsbove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

(1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Bornover. At all times when the note is held by an insured lende, Bornover shall continue to make sprants, on the content, a collection spant for the holder.
