default, the Morgagee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise accursed, the balance their remaining in the funds accumulated upder (b) of paragraph 2 preceding, as a credit against the amount of principal them remaining unpuld under the note secured hereby, and shall properly adjust any payments which shall have been made under (c) of paragraph 2.

- 4. That he will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, or impositions, for which provision has not been made hereinbefore, and in default thereof the Mortgages may pay the same; and that he will promptly deliver the official receipts therefor to the Mortgages. If the Mortgage falls to make any payments provided for in this section or say other payments for isses, assessments, or the like, the Mortgages may pay the same, and all sums so paid shall bear interest at the rate set forth in the note secured hereby from the date of such advance and shall be secured by this mortgage.
- 5. That he will keep the premises in as good order and condition as they are now and will not commit or permit any waste thereof, reasonable wear and tear excepted.
- 6. That he will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and other hazards, casualities and contingencies in such amounts and for such periods as may be required by the Mortgages and will pay promptly, when due, any premiums on such insurance provision for payment of which has not been made hereinbefore. That he hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the morigaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Morigagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the sents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.
- 8. The Mortgagor further agrees that should this mortgage and the note secured hereby not be eligible for insurance under the National Housing Act within of the Department of Housing and Urban Development or suthorized agent of the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development dated subsequent to the time from the date of this mortgage, declining to insure said note and this mortgage, being deemed conclusive proof of such ineligibility the Mortgagee or the holder of the note may, at its option, declare all sums secured hereby immediately due and payable.
- 9. The Mortgagor covenants and agrees that so long as this mortgage and the said note secured hereby are insured under the provisions of the National Housing Act, he will not execute or file for record any instrument which imposes a restriction upon the sale or occupancy of the mortgaged property on the basis of race, color, or creed. Upon any violation of this undertaking, the Mortgagee may, at its option, declare the unpaid balance of the debt secured hereby immediately due and payable.
- It is agreed that the Mortgagor shall hold and enjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note secured hereby. Its the true meaning of this instrument that if the Mortgagor shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covenants of this mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, that then this mortgage shall be utterly null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note secured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgager oil sums then owing by the Mortgagor to the Mortgage shall become immediately due and payable and this mortgage may be foreclosed. The Mortgagor waives the benefit of any appraisement laws of the State of South Carolina. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or should the Mortgagee become a party to any suit involving this mortgage or the title to the premises described herein, or should the debt secured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at law for collection by suit or otherwise, all coats and expenses (including continuation of abstract) incurred by the Mortgagee, and a reasonable sittorney's fee, shall thereupon become due and payable immediately or on demand, at the option of the Mortgagee, as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.

The covenants herein contained shall bind, and the benefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and essigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular number shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
