NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgage to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dallars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in and well and truly paid by the Mortgagor in and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and reclose unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situatelying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 280, Section 6, Sheet Two, of a Subdivision known as Colonial Hills as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineers & Architects, dated March 21, 1968, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book WWW, at Page 13, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iroh pin on the southern side of Creighton Street, joint front corner of Lots 279 and 280, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 16-40 E, 214 feet to a point in a creek; thence along said creek as the line, a traverse line being N. 79-59 E. 100.0 feet, to a point in said creek, at the rear corner of Lot 281; thence along the line of that lot, N. 16-35 W. 325.0 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Creighton Street; thence along the southern side of Creighton Street, S. 73-25 W. 100.0 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by W. N. Leslie by deed dated January 20, 1970, to be recorded herewith.

The mortgagor's promissory note referred to above contains, among other things, a provision for an increase in the interest rate.
