NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

ALL that certain lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 125, of a subdivision known as Oakcrest, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book GG, at page 131, and more particularly described according to survey made by Joseph P. Roston, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Lynhurst Drive, front corner of Lot 126, and running thence with the line of said lot, N. 29-12 E., 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 60-48 W., 70 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot 124;;thence with the line of said lot S. 29-12 W., 150 feetto an iron pin on said Drive; thence with said Drive, S. 60-48 E., 70 feet to the point of beginning.
