"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 108 of a subdivision known as Coleman Heights, according to plat prepared by Terry T. Dill, Surveyor, February 1958, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book RR at Page 115. According to said plat, the property is more fully described as follows:

BEGINNING At an iron pin on the western side of West Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 107 and 108 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 66-37 W. 280.9 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 107 and 108; thence with the line of Lot 108, S. 17-01 E. 150.4 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 108 and 113; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 66-35 E. 297.4 feet to an iron pin on the western side of West Drive; thence with said drive, N. 23-05 W. 150 feet to the point of beginning.
