"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the southern side of West Earle Street, being shown as lot 3 and the western half of lot 2 as shown on plat of property of Floride S. Miller made by R. E. Dalton, Surveyor, April, 1919, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book E at Page 99 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point on the southern side of West Earle Street 90 feet from the southwestern corner of Robinson and West Earle Streets and running thence S. 6-28 W. 198.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84-19 W. 87.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 5-42 E. 196 feet to an iron pin on West Earle Street; thence with the southern side of West Earle Street S. 85-38 E. 90 feet to the beginning corner.
