State of South Carolina: All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with buildings and improvements thereon, being known and designated as Lot No. 283, Section VI, Sheet Two, of a subdivision known as Colonial Heights, as shown on a plat thereof, prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, dated March 21, 1968, recorded in the R.H.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "MW", page 13, and according to a more recent survey and plat by Campbell and Clarkson, Registered Surveyors, dated January 14, 1972, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
