"All that certain piece, pared or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, altuate, lying and being in the Binto of Bouth Carolina, Country of Greenville, altuate on the northern side of Maximillan Drive, being shown as lot no. 1 on a plat entitled "Property belonging to Frank B. Edwards, Greenville Country, South Carolina" prepared by H. B. Frankenfield, Jr., dated December 11, 1956, and also lots nos. 1969, 1970 and 1971 on a plat of the property of Lake Lauter Development prepared by George Kershaw, dated October 7, 1925, and recorded in Plat Book G at Page 60 in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville Country, and also being shown as a tract containing 1.127 acres on a plat of the property of Walter H. and Helen E. Euler dated November, 1972, prepared by Sam T. Marlowe and Associates and recorded in Plat Book $g_{\mu\nu}$ at Page 11, in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville Country and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BECINNING at all from pin on the northern aide of Maximillan Drive at the joint front corner of lot 1 and 10t 2 and running thence with Maximillan Drive N. 77-45 W. 145.18 feet to an iron pin at the corner of a County Road; thence with said Road N. 24-00 W. 273.79 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Maxorrick Loop; thence with said Loop 8. 81-11 K. 137 feet to an iron pin; thence still with said Loop N. 78-25 K. 120.06 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of lot 1 and lot 2; thence 8. 0-03 K. 283.99 feet to the point of boginning.
