MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST, FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (bereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of Nineteen Thousand and No/100ths

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's necount, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof Mortgagoe its successors and assigns the following described real estate:
