

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, self and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville located at the Northeast corner of the intersection of Old Spartanburg Road (Now East North Street Extension) and a 40-foot unnamed street, being shown as LOT No. 54 in Block E, on plat of property of Corrine T. Bates as Trustce made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers in May 1946 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

East North Street Extension and a 40-foot unnamed street and running thence along the East side of said unnamed street N. 31-00 West 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56-37 East 100.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot No. 55, S. 28-30 East 200 feet to an iron pin on North side of East North Street Extension; running thence with the North side of said East North Street Extension, S. 56-37 West 100 feet to the point of beginning.
