TOOETHER with all and singular the rights, members bereditinents, and appartenurces to the same belowing or in any way incellent or apportuning, including all builton stores and refrigerators beating, an exceptionance planding and chetical lixtures, will to wall empeting, fences and gites, and any other equipment or fixtures row or beneather attached or nested in fitted to any manace it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than boost hold building, be considered a part of the reality.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortengee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortriger represents and warrants that said Mortrager is selected of the above described premiers in fee snaple absolute; that the above described premiers are free and clear of all hears or other enound rances, that the Mortrager is limitedly empowered to convey or creamber the same, and that the Mortrager will forever detend the said premiers unto the Mortrager, its soccessors and assigns, from and against the Mortrager and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mertgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional sums which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgage, to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes, and all soms so advanced shall lear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgager will keep the improvements on the mentgaged premises, whether now existing or Lereafter to be creeked, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgagee, and Mortgagee should it so require and shall include less payable clauses in favor of the Mortgagee; and in the event of loss, Mortgager will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgagee by registered and, and should the Mortgager at any time fail to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premiums for such insurance, then the Mortgagee may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgager and reimburse itself for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so, the Mortgagor may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness occurred hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgage immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagoe may, at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtodness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by inference.
- 8. That the Mortgagor will not further encumber the premises above described, without the prior consent of the Mortgagoe, and should the Mortgagor so encumber such premises, the Mortgagoe may, at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 9. That should the Mortgagor alienate the mortgaged premises by Contract of Sale, Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Mortgagor or his Purchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortgage indebtedness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption, furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the loan balance existing at the time of transfer modified by increasing the interest rate on the said loan balance to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina Low, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mortgagor or his purchaser of the new interest rate and monthly payments, and will mal him a new passbook. Should the Mortgagor, or his Purchaser, fail to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph the Mortgagee, at its option, may declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
- 10. That should the Mortgagor fad to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and the same shall be unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or if there should be any failure to comply with and abide by any by-laws or the charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgagee, the Mortgagee, at its option, may write to the Mortgagor at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said default and should the Mortgagor ful to rectify said default within the said thirty days, the Mortgagee, may at its option, increase the interest rate on the loan balance for the remaining term of the loan or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be adjusted accordingly.
- 11. That should the Mortgagor fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory rate and should any monthly installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%) per centum of any such past due installment in order to cover the extra expense incident to the handling of such delinquent payments.
- 12. That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, all the rents, issues, and profits accroing from the mortgaged premises, retaining the right to collect the same so long as the debt hereby secured is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, takes, or fire insurance premiums, be past due and unpaid, the Mortgagee may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured, without hability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection, and any tenant is authorized, upon request by Mortgagee, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgage, without liability to the Mortgage, until should said premises at the time of such default he occupied by the Mortgage, the Mortgagee may apply to the Judge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Count of Common Fleas who shall be resident or presiding in the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such rents and profits, applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage debt without liability to account for anything more than the rents and prefits actually collected.
- 13. That the Mortgagee, at its option, may require the Mortgagor to pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiums that will not become due and payable on policies of mortgage guaranty insurance (if applicable), fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premises (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor, divided by the number of months to chapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by Mortgage to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgage for taxes, assessments, or invarance premiums, the excess may be credited by the Mortgage on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor if however, said sums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee may, at its option, apply for renewal of mortgage guarants or shallar invarance (if applicable) covering the halance then remaining due on the mortgage debt, and the Mortgagor may at its option, pay the single premium required for the remaining years of the term, or the Mortgagee may pay such premium and add the same to the mortgage debt in which event the Mortgagor shall repay to Mortgagee such premium payment, with interest, at the rate specified in said promissory note, in equal monthly installments over the remaining payment period.
