AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties hereto, that the said mortgagor OUP heirs, executors, or administrators, shall keep the buildings erected, or to be erected on said premises, insured against loss or damage by fire, for the benefit

of the said mortgagee, for an amount not less than Six Thousand Ninety Six Dollars and 00/100 - Dollars, in such company as shall be approved by the said mortgagee, and shall deliver the policy to the said mortgagee, and in default thereof,

the said mortgagee Consolidated Credit Corporation of Greenville, S.C. Inc. or assigns, may effect such insurance and reimburse themselves under this mortgage for the expense thereof, with interest thereof, from the date of its payment. And it is further agreed, in the event of other insurance and contribution between the insurers, that the said mortgagee

then the said mortgagee. Consolidated Credit Corporation of Greenville, South Carolina, Inc., or assigns, may cause the same to be paid, together with all penalties and costs incurred thereon, and reimborse themselves under this mortgage for the sums so paid, with interest thereon, from the dates of such payments.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the said parties, that upon any default being made in the payment of the interest on the aid Note, or of the insurance premiums, or of the taxes, or of the assessments hereinabove mentioned, when the same shall severally first become payable, or in any other of the provisions of this mortgage, that then the entire amount of the debt secured, or

mended to be secured hereby, shall forthwith become due, at the option of the said mortgagee,

or assigns, although the period for the payment of the said debt may not then have expired.

AND IT IS AGREED, That if the holder of the Note secured hereby is compelled to pay any taxes upon the debt represented by said note, or by this mortgage, then, and in that event, unless the said taxes are paid by some party other than the said holder, that then the emire amount of the debt secured, or intended to be secured, shall forthwith become due at the option of the said mortgage,

or assigns, although the period for its payment may not then have expired.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the said parties, that, should legal proceedings be instituted for the collection of the delt

secured hereby, then and in that event, the said mortgagee. Consolidated Credit Corporation Inc. or assigns, shall have the right to have a Receiver appointed of the rests and profits of the above described premises, with power to forthwith lease out the said premises anew if he should so elect, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings, and the execution of the said trust as Receiver, shall apply the residue of the said rents and profits towards the payment of the debts secured hereby.
