MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS,

MABEL LARIZ

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly Indebted unto WILTON E. PEARSON AND JOYCE W. PEARSON

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTEEN AND 20/100 Dollars is 1,613.20 ; due and payable

at the rate of \$26.00 per month on the first day of each month beginning June 1, 1974 and continuing until principal and interest have been paid in full. Said payments shall be applied first to interest, balance to principal with interest thereon from date at the rate of Nine per contum per annum, to be paid: Monthly

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE, being in the Piedmont Manufacturing Co. Village, in or near the Town of Piedmont, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 55, Section No. 3, as shown on plat entitled "Property of Piedmont Mfg. Co., Greenville County" made by Dalton & Neves, February 1950, Section 3 and 4 of said plat are recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in plat book Y at page 2-5. According to said plat, the within described lot is also known as No. 11, Piedmont Avenue and fronts thereon 96 feet.

It is understood and agreed that this mortgage is second and junior in lien to that mortgage held by Saluda Valley Federal Savings & Loan Association in the original amount of \$9,600.00 executed by William L. Finley, Jr., Clara L. Finley and Mabel Lariz.



Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtegances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto inat all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomspever tawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
