and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, the lands and rights,"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or heretofore unenclosed theron situated, lying and being  
in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Gantt Township, adjoining lands now  
or formerly of C. C. Good, Southern Railroad Company, T. B. Freeman, L. M.  
Cochran and G. A. Ellis, and containing 10 acres, more or less, according  
to survey made by J. H. Southern on October 1, 1910, and having the  
following metes and bounds according to survey made and plat by C. M.
