All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Butler Township, about one mile north of Cross Roads Baptist Church, lying on the west side of the road that leads from the leads from the Batesville Road to the said Cross Roads Baptist Church, and being a part of the tract No. 2 as described in Deed recorded in the office of the R.M.C. in Deed Book 168 at page 136, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-
