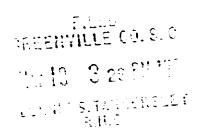

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagoe) in the full and just sum of

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain

conditions), said note to be repaid with interest as the rate or rates therein specified in installments of Two Hundred Sixty-

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any fulture to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole ansount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgazor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgazoe to the Mortgazor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgazor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgazoe at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is bareby adhowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgazoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or let of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the easterly side of Shrevewood Drive, and being known and designated as Lot No. 124 on a plat of BROOK GLENN GARDENS, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book JJJ at Page 85, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 124 and 125 and running thence with the joint line of said Lots, N.60-17 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; running thence with the line of Lot 130, N.29-43 W. 110 feet to an iron pin; running thence with the line of Lot 123, S.60-17 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of Shrevewood Drive; running thence with the easterly side of said Drive, S.29-43 E. 110 feet to the point of beginning.
