Attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for additional

And said mortgagor agrees to keep the buildings and Improvements now standing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged premises and any and all apparatus, fixtures and appurterances now or hereafter in or attached to said buildings or improvements, insured against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as the mortgagee may from time to time require, all such insurance to be in forms, in companies and in sums (not less than sufficient to avoid any claim on the part of the insurers for co-insurance) satisfactory to the mortgagee; that all insurance policies shall be held by and shall be for the benefit of and first payable in case of loss to the mortgagee, and that at least fifteen days before the expiration of each such policy, a new and sufficient policy to take the place of the one so expiring shall be delivered to the mortgagee. The mortgagor hereby assigns to the mortgagee all moneys recoverable under each such policy, and agrees that in the event of a loss the amount collected under any policy of insurance on said property may, at the option of the mortgagee may determine; or said amount or any portion thereof may, at the option of the mortgage, either be used in replacing, repairing or restoring the improvements partially or totally destroyed to a condition satisfactory to said mortgagee, or be released to the mortgagor in either of which events the mortgagee shall not be obligated to see to the proper application thereof; nor shall the amount so released or used he deemed a payment on any indebtedness secured hereby. In case of default in the payment of any part of the principal indebtedness, or of any part of the interest, at the time the same becomes due, or in the case of failure to keep insured for the benefit of the mortgagee the houses and buildings on the premises against fire and tornado risk, and other casualties or contingencies, as herein provided, or in case of failure to pay any taxes or assessments to become due on said property within the time required by law; in either of said cases the mortgagee shall be entitled to declare the entire debt due and to institute foreclosure proceedings.

And it is further covenanted and agreed that in the event of the passage, after the date of this mortgage, of any law of the State of South Carolina deducting from the value of land, for the purpose of taxing any lien thereon, or changing in any way the laws now in force for the taxation of mortgages or debts secured by mortgage for State or local purposes, or the manner of the collection of any such taxes, so as to affect this mortgage, the whole of the principal sum secured by this mortgage, together with the interest due thereon, shall, at the option of the said mortgagee, without notice to any party, become immediately due and payable.
