TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, numbers, herebit monts, and appartendings to the same believing or in any way incident or apportuning, including all Fultern stokes and refrigerations heating are conditionally placed by the district will to wall carpeting, fences and gates, and any other copiquent or factores new or hereafter attached, corrected in a titoch in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment other than hereal Distriction be considered a partiel the reality.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortzazce, its so cessors and assizus forever

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is seized of the above described premises in the simple absolute, that the above described premises are free and clear of all hers or other encombrances, that the Mortgagor is lawfully encowered to convey or encomber the same, and that the Mortgagor will forever detend the sand premises unto the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
- 2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagee for any additional suns which may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance premiums, repairs or other such purposes pursuant to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgager under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes, and all sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter to be erected, insined against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereinder at any time and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgagee, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagee and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagee should it so require and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgagee, and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give immediate notice thereof to the Mortgagee by registered rand, and should the Mortgagor at any time full to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premisms for such insurance, then the Mortgagee may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagor and reimburse itself for the cest of such insurance, with interest as hereinalove provided.
- 4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so the Mortgagoe may, at its option, enter upon said premises and in the whatever repairs are necessary and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
- 5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the issuance and maintenance of insurance upon the life of any person obligated under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
- 6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof and to exhibit the receipts therefor at the offices of the Mortgagee immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagee may, at its option pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as above provided.
- 7. That if this mortgage secures a "construction loan", the Mortgager agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgager in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
- 8. That the Mortgagor will not further encounter the premises above described, without the prior consent of the Mortgagoe, and should the Mortgagor so encounter such premises the Mortgagor may at its option declare the indicatories hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indicatedness.
- 9. That should the Mortgagor allegate the mortgaged premises by Contract of Sale Bond for Title, or Deed of Conveyance, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Mortgagor or his Purchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortgage indebtedness, pay the reasonable cost as required by the Association for processing the assumption furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Bond for Title or Deed of Conveyance, and have the interest rate on the loan balance existing at the time of transfer modified by increasing the interest rate on the said bun balance to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mortgagor or his penchaser of the new interest rate and monthly payments, and will mail him a new possbook. Should the Mortgagor, or his Purchaser, full to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph, the Mortgagor, at its option, may declare the inhibitedness hereby second to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said inhibitedness.
- 10. That should the Mortgagor ful to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and the same shall be urpaid for a period of thirty (30) days or if there should be any fadure to comply with and abide by any by-laws or the charter of the Mortgagor, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgagor at its option may write to the Mortgagor at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said defull and should the Mortgagor fail to rectify said defull within the said thirty days the Mortgagor, may, at its option, increase the interest rate on the lean before for the remaining term of the loan or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per armum permitted to be charged at that the edge applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be adjusted accordingly.
- 11. That should the Mortzazor ful to redde payments of principal and intensit as the on the promissory note and should any monthly installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortzazoe may collect a Title charge not to excess an amount equal to five (5%) per centum of any such past due installment in order to cover the extra expense incident to the handling of such delinquent payments.
- 12. That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns all the rents issues and profits accrning from the mortgaged premises retaining the right to collect the same so long as the debt hereby secured is not in arrears of payment but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fire mortgage premiums, he past due and impaid the Mortgagoe may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured, without hability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, loss the cost of collection and any tenent is authorized, upon request by Mortgagoe, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagoe without liability to the Mortgagor until natified to the contrary by the Mortgagoe, and should said premises at the time of such defent be occupied by the Mortgagor, the Mortgagoe have apply to the Indge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Court of Common Pleas who shall be reader to presiding in the county aforestid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect such roots and profits, applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage debt without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
- 13. That the Mortgagee, at its option, may require the Mortgager to pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each mosth until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sums in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note: a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of mortgage guaranty insurance (if applicable), fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premises (all as estimated by the Mortgagee) less all sums already paid therefor, divided by the number of months to clapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sums to be held by Mortgagee to pay said premiums, taxes and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgage for taxes, assessments or insurance premiums, the excess may be credited by the Mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor; if, however, said sums shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same doll become due and payable, the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amounts necessary to make up the deficiency. The Mortgagor further agrees that at the end of ten years from the date bereof.
