WHEREAS, the said Mortgagor(s) in and by their certain promissory note in writing, of even date with well and truly indebted to W. Morris Barton - - - these Presents, are

hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just sum of Three Thousand & No/100 - - - (\$3,000.00) - - - DOLLARS,

to be paid as follows: Five years after date,

at the rate of four per centum per annum, to be computed with interest thereon from date and paid annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection the Mortgagor(s) agrees to pay all costs and expenses including a reasonable amount as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Morris Barton and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, on the South side of Benjamin Avenue, near the City of Greer and southward therefrom, and being Lot No. 39 of a Subdivision known as "BROOKHAVEN", according to survey and plat by H. S. Brockman, Registered Surveyor, dated December 12, 1957, Amended September 1, 1959, recorded in Plat Book RR, Page 41, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Benjamin Avenue, at the corner of Lots Nos. 38 and 39, and running thence as the common line of said lots, S. 10-55 W. 170 feet to an iron pin at corner of Lot No. 52; thence S. 79-25 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, corner of Con Lot No. 40; thence along the line of Lot No. 40, N. 10-55 E. 170 feet to an iron pin on the south side of Benjamin Avenue; thence along said Avenue, N. 79-25 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
