first installment being due and payable on or before the with interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum from the date of marurity of said note until paid, and said Morrgagor having further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent (10%) of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, 200 feet Northwest of the Keeler Mill Road about one (1) mile Northwest from Armstrong School, being a portion of fract No. 4 of the Norwood Property and having according to a Plat of the Property of Frank Massey and William Robert Massey, dated August 4, 1971, made by Jones Engineering Service, recorded in the RIX Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book 48 Page 195, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of property now or formerly owned by the Boy Scouts of America, said iron pin being located 200 feet more or less, Northwest from the Northern side of the Keeler Mill Road and running thence along the line of the Scout property, N-56-30 E 80 feet to an iron pin; thence a new line through property owned by the Grantor, N-42-55 W 186.7 feet to an iron pin on the line of property owned by Scott; thence along the line of said property, S-56-30 ¥ 128 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the line of property owned by Scott, S-56-30 E 200 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.

The above described property is a portion of the same conveyed to the * TOGETHER WITH all and singular the ways, easements, riparian and other rights, and all tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and all buildings, structures and other improvements now on said land or that bereafter may be erected or placed thereon, and all fixtures attached thereto and all rents, income, issues and profits accruing and to accrue therefrom.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described property unto Mortgagee, his beirs, successors, and assigns forever.

Mortgagor hereby covenants with Mortgagee that Mortgagor is indeteasibly seized with the absolute and fee simple title to said property; that Mortgagor has full power and lawful authority to sell, convey, assign, transfer and mortgage the same; that it shall be lawful for Mortgagee at any time hereafter peaceably and quietly to enter upon, have, hold and enjoy said property and every part thereof; that said property is free and discharged from all liens, encumbrances and claims of every kind, including all taxes and assessments; that Mortgagor will, at his own expense, make such other and further instruments and assurances to vest absolute and fee simple title to said property in Mortgagee that may be requested by Mortgagee; and that Mortgagor will, and his heirs, legal representatives and successors shall, warrant and defend the title to said property unto Mortgagee against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

PROVIDED ALWAYS, and these presents are upon these express conditions, that if the said Mortgagor shall promptly, well and truly pay to the Morgagee the said debt or sum of money aforesaid, according to the true intent and tenor of said note, and until full payment thereof, or any extensions or renewals thereof in whole or in part, and payment of all other indebtedness or liability that may become due and owing hereunder and secured hereby, shall faithfully and promptly comply with and perform each and every other covenant and provision herein on the part of the Mortgagor to be complied with and performed, then this deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine, and be unterly void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

And Mortgagor hereby covenants as follows:

To keep the buildings, structures and other improvements now or hereafter erected or placed on the premises insured in an amount not less than the principal amount of the note aforesaid against all loss or damage by fire, windstorm, tornado and water damage, as may be required by the Mortgagee, with loss, if any, payable to the Mortgagee as his interest may appear; to deposit with the Mortgagee policies with standard mortgagee clause, without contribution, evidencing such insurance; to keep said premises and all improvements thereon in first class condition and repair. In case of loss, Mortgagee in hereby authorized to adjust and settle any claim under any such policy and Mortgagee is authorized to collect and receipt for any such insurance money and to apply the same, at Mortgagee's option, in reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured, whether due or not, or to allow Morigagor to use such insurance money, or any part thereof, in repairing the damage or restoring the improvements or other property without affecting the lien hereof for the full amount secured hereby.

It is further covenanced that Mortgagee may (but shall not be obligated so to do) advance moneys that should have been paid by Mortgagor hereunder in order to protect the lien or security hereof, and Morteagor agrees without demand to forthwith repay such moneys, which amount shall bear inverest from the date so advanced until paid at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum and shall be considered as so much additional indebtedness secured hereby; but no payment by Montgazee of any such moneys shall be deemed a waiver of Montgagee's right to declare the principal sum due hereunder by reason of the default or violation of Montgagor in any of his covenants hereunder.

Mortgagor further covenants that granting any extension or extensions of the time payment of any part or all of the total indebtedness or liability secured hereby, or taking other or additional security for payment thereof, shall not affect this mortgage or the rights of Mortgagee herewider, or overare as a release from any liability upon any part of the indebtedness hereby secured, under any covenant herein contained. *Grantor by Deed of Ralph Massey, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Deed Book 278, Page 147, and is hereby conveyed subject to rights of way and easements of public record.

The above said portion of said tract No. 4 and being according to said Plat (Book 4K, Page 195), is the exact property conveyed August 25, 1971 by Deed of Frank Massey to William Robert Massey, heirs and assigns forever; said Deed having been recorded August 25, 1971 in the REC Office of Greenville County South Carolina in Deed Book 923 at Page 409.
