TRACT ONE: All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as lot Number 119 of Plat Number 2 of the property of the Tryon Development Company, known as Lake Lanier, made by George Kershaw, C. E. and duly recorded in the Office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Plat Book Number G, at Page 36.

Together with all rights and privileges conveyed with his property in Deed to me.
