The Muripaped covernants that it is havinly secred of the premiers hereinal-ove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and it having authorized to sell, comes or encumber the same, and that the premiers are free and clear of all here and encumbrations except as herein specifically stated otherwise as follows:

The Mortgages further covenants to marrant and forever defend all and singular the said premiers unto the Mortgages forever, from and against the Mortgages and all persons whomesees lawfully claiming the same or any part thereod

The Meetings further coverants and agrees as follows

- (1) That this incite age whall so care the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public invessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the coverants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further foams, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagee to the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the outpinal amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall be as interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in urrang.
