WHEREAS, JAMES M. MARTIN ----

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto BLUE FLAME CREDIT UNION------

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(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Eight Thousand and No/100-----

----- Dollars (\$ 8,000.00-) due and payable in 129 bi-weekly payments of \$82.00, principal and interest, with a final payment of \$78.80, the first such payment being due and payably on September 2, 1979,

with interest thereon from date at the rate of

per centum per annum, to be paid as provided in said note; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the Northwestern side of Club Circle, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 19 A on plat of property of Roy W. Boggess and Walter L. Miller, Jr., (formerly property of Greenville Motor Boat Club, Inc.), made by Jones & Sutherland, Engineers, dated January 8, 1960, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book UU at Page 7 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Club Circle at the joint front corner of Lots 19 and 19A and runs thence along the line of Lot 19 N. 47-15 W., 304.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 8-14 W., 37.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 37-01 W., 65.4 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 18 A S. 50-38 E., 293.7 feet to an iron pin on the Northwestern side of Club Circle; thence with the curve of Club Circle, the chord being N. 22-44 E., 85 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to James M. Martin and Virginia P. Martin by deed of Neal J. Hardy, of Washington, D.C., as Federal Housing Commission recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Deed Book 697 at Page 51 on April 25, 1962. Subsequently, Virginia P. Martin conveyed her undivided onehalf interest in and to the within described property to James M. Martin by dged recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in Deed Book 996 at Page 185 on March 28, 1974. This note and mortgage are junior in priority to that certain note and mortgage heretofore given to Cameron-Brown Company recorded in the Greenville County RMC Office in REM Book 888 at Page 251, which has a

present balance in the sum of \$7,503.17.
Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

- (1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.
- (2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.

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
