MORTGAGE

THIS MORTGAGE is made this 21st day of May, 1980, between the Mortgagor, Alice Marie Martin, (herein "Borrower"), and the Mortgagee, First Federal Savings and Loan Association, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, whose address is 301 College Street, Greenville, South Carolina (herein "Lender").

WHEREAS, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of Twenty Five Thousand Five Hundred Fifty and No/100 Dollars, which indebtedness is evidenced by Borrower's note dated May 21, 1980, (herein "Note"), providing for monthly installments of principal and interest, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on June 1, 2005.....;

TO SECURE to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, and (b) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or unit, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Unit No. 44 of the Highlands Horizontal Property Regime as is more fully described in Master Deed dated August 25, 1972, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 953 at Page 113-182, and survey and plot plans recorded in Plat Book 4S at Pages 20, 21 and 22, as amended by First Amendment to Master Deed dated March 5, 1974 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 996 at Pages 45-99, inclusive, said new survey and plot plans being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5F at Pages 18-20.
