BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeast side of Pinckney Street which iron pin is situated 128 feet southeast of the intersection of Briggs Avenue and running thence N. 56-0 E. 125 feet; thence S. 34-0 E. 50 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of an alley; thence along said alley S. 56-0 W. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence along Pinckney Street N. 34-0 W. 50 feet to the point of beginning.

As recorded in the records of the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina the title is now vested in William D. Hallums by deed of Allan A. Walsh and Frank W. Walsh as recorded in Deed Book 869 at page 87 on May 30, 1969.

IT IS HEREBY UNDERSTOOD THAT THIS MORTGAGE CONSTITUTES A VALID SECOND LIES ON THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PROPERTY.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises unto the said mortgages, its (his) successors, heirs and assigns forever.

AND I (we) do hereby bind my (our) self and my (our) heirs, executors and administrators, to procure or execute any further necessary assurances of title to the earl premises, the title to which is unencumbered, and also to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said mortgagee its (his) heirs, successors and assigns, from and against all persons lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the parties hereto, that the said mortgagor(s) his (their) heirs, executors, or administrators, shall keep the buildings on said premises, insured against loss or damage by fire, for the benefit of the said mortgages, for an amount not less than the unpuld balance on the said Note in such company as shall be approved by the said mortgages, and in default thereof, the said mortgages, its (his) heirs, successors or assigns, may effect such insurance and reimburse themselves under this martgage for the expense thereof, with interest thereon, from the date of its payment. And it is further agreed that the said mortgages its (his) heirs, successors or assigns shall be entitled to receive from the insurance moneys to be paid, a sum equal to the amount of the debt secured by this mortgage.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the said parties, that if the said mortgogor(s), his (their) heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, shall fail to pay all taxes and assessments upon the said premises when the same shall first become payable, then the said mortgages, its (his) heirs, successors or assigns, may cause the same to be paid, together with all penalties and costs incurred thereon, and relimburse themselves under this mortgage for the sums so paid, with interest thereon, from the dates of such payments.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the said parties, that upon any default being made in the payment of the said Note, when the same shall become payable, or in any other of the provisions of this morigage, that then the entire amount of the debt secured, or intended to be secured hereby, shall forthwith become due, at the option of the said morigage, its (his) heirs, successors or assigns, although the period for the payment of the said debt may not then have expired.

AND IT IS FURTHER AGREED, by and between the said parties, that should legal proceedings be instituted for the foreclosure of this mortgage, or for any purpose involving this mortgage, or should the debt hereby secured be placed in the hands of an attorney at low for collection, by suit or otherwise; that all costs and expenses incurred by the mortgages, its (his) heirs, successors or assigns, including a reasonable counsel fee (of not less than ten per cent of the amount involved) shall thereupon become due and payable as a part of the debt secured hereby, and may be recovered and collected hereunder.
