MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, Rosella Farley, formerly Rosella A. Rhodes

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto The City of Greenville, a Municipal Corporation, Post Office Box 2207, Greenville, South Carolina 29602

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Eleven Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Five and No/100-----
-----Dollars (\$ 11,245.00) due and payable

in 120 monthly installments over a ten year period, due on the fifteenth day of each month commencing July 15, 1982

with interest thereon from July 15, 1982 at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be paid: \$124.84 monthly

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Woodfin Avenue (formerly McKay Street) and being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 3 on plat of Property of James Birnie recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C", at Page 200 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Woodfin Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3 and running thence along the joint line of said lots S. 53-15 E. 110.75 feet, to an iron pin; thence S. 87-35 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 3 and 4 N. 3-15 W. 110.58 feet, to an iron pin on the south side of Woodfin Avenue; thence along said Avenue N. 86-15 E. 50 feet to the point of beginning.

THIS property is known and designated as Block Book No. 95-9-6.

BEING the same property conveyed to the mortgagor, then known as Rozella A. Rhodes by deed of Bessie B. Miller, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 821 page 436, on June 12, 1967.

THIS mortgage is junior and subordinate to a mortgage executed by Rozella A. Rhodes to Cameron-Brown Company; recorded in REM Book 1060 at page 233, on June 12, 1967. Said mortgage was assigned to Federal National Mortgage Association, as recorded in REM Book 1062 page 656, on July 10, 1967.

FUTURE ADVANCES: As additional consideration, pursuant to Section 29-3-50 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, this mortgage is given to cover, in addition to all existing indebtedness of Mortgagor to Mortgagee (including but not limited to the above described advances) evidenced by promissory notes, and all renewal and extensions thereof, all future advances that may be made to Mortgagor by Mortgagee, to be evidenced by promissory notes, and all renewal and extensions thereof, the maximum principle amount of all existing indebtedness and future advances outstanding at any one time not to exceed \$12,500 plus interest thereon, attorney's fees and court costs as provided herein.
