NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaic debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel er lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville and being on the Northern side of Seventh Street in Section 4 of Judson Mills Village, being known and designated as Lot No. 44 on plat of property of Judson Mills Village made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers in January 1941 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at Page 75 and 76 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northern side of Seventh Street at joint front corner of Lots 44 and 45 and said pin also being 54 feet East from the Northeast corner of the intersection of Seventh Street and Neubert Avenue and running thence with line of Lot 45, North 1-42 West 122.5 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot 80, North 88-10 East 80 feet to an iron pin; thence with line of Lot 43, South 1-42 East 122.5 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Seventh Street; thence with the Northern side of Seventh Street, South 88-10 West 80 feet to the beginning corner.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomspever family claiming the same or any part thereof.
