2.17 Proofs of Claim. In the case of any receivership, insolvency, bankruptcy, reorganization, arrangement, adjustment, composition or other proceedings affecting the Borrower, its creditors or its property, the Lender, to the extent permitted by law, shall be entitled to file such proofs of claim and other documents as may be necessary or advisable in order to have the claims of the Lender allowed in such proceedings for the entire amount of the Indebtedness at the date of the institution of such proceedings and for any additional amount of the Indebtedness after such date.

ARTICLE III

- 3.01 <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. This Mortgage shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon the Borrower and the Lender and their respective heirs, executors, legal representatives, successors, successors-in-title and assigns. Whenever a reference is made in this Mortgage to "Borrower" or "Lender" such reference shall be deemed to include a reference to the heirs, executors, legal representatives, successors, successors-in-title and assigns of the Borrower and the Lender, as the case may be. The provisions of this Paragraph 3.01 are subject to the restrictions on transfer contained in Paragraph 1.17.
- 3.02 Terminology. All personal pronouns used in this Mortgage whether used in the masculine, feminine or neuter gender, shall include all other genders; the singular shall include the plural, and vice versa. Titles of articles and paragraphs are for convenience only and neither limit nor amplify the provisions of this Mortgage, and all references herein to articles, paragraphs or subparagraphs shall refer to the corresponding articles, paragraphs or subparagraphs of this Mortgage unless specific reference is made to articles,
