
STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

MORTGAGE OF REAL PROPERTY

This is a portion of the property conveyed to George D. Stewart and Sybil M. Stewart by deed of Nannie T. Dickens, Joe Neva Turner and Mollie T. Cason, formerly Mollie T. Stewart died testate on December 2, 1971, devising the within described property to Sandra Jo Lynn Stewart Evette, now by marriage, Sandra Jo Lynn Stewart Evette Cisson.
