TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:
THIS MORTGAGE SECURES FUTURE ADVANCESWIRREAS, BESSIE M DOWLING

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto Associates Financial Services Company of South Carolina, Inc., its successors and assigns forever (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's loan agreement of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the amount of \$ 16,878.57, together with interest as provided in the loan agreement.

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums and other obligations for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, the Maximum Outstanding at any given time not to exceed said amount stated above, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE, to wit: Near the Duncan Chapel School and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Thompson Road (now known as Duncan Chapel Road) and Burns Cross Road and running thence along the Southwest side of Thompson Road (now Duncan Chapel Road), N. 62-53 West 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 24-02 West 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-53 E. 118 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Burns Cross Road; thence along the Eastern side of Burns Cross Road, N. 24-02 East 200 feet along the Ellison Property line to an iron pin at the original corner of Parker Land Co. property; thence across Burns Cross Road, N. 62-53 West 18 feet to an iron pin at the point of beginning and containing 0.46 ACRES, more or less.

ALSO: All that other piece, parcel or lot of land in the County and State aforesaid being shown and designated as Property of Kenneth E. Langford on a plat prepared by Jones Engineering Service on May 6, 1975 and according to said plat, having the following metes and bounds: BEGINNING at an iron pin at joint front corner of property now or formerly owned by Kenneth E. Longford on the Southern side of Duncan Chapel Road (Sometimes known as Thompson Road) and running thence with the former line of Langford property, S. 24-02 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 62-53 West 35 feet to an iron pin; thence with property line of Pearl Langford, N. 24-02 East 200 feet to an iron pin; thence with the Southern edge of Duncan Chapel Road, S. 62-53 East (see pg. 2

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as herein specifically stated otherwise as follows:

The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.

(2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgagee debt, whether due or not.

(3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected in good repair, and, in the case of a construction loan, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgage debt.

(4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other impositions against the mortgaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged premises.
