

SCHEDULE A

All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown on survey prepared for Carol & Huston Lindsey by W.R. Williams, Jr., R.S., July 1, 1970, and according to said plat has the following courses and distances: BEGINNING at a pin in the center of South Carolina Highway No. 11 and running thence S. 15-11 E. 1098.3 feet to a stone on the line of Robert F. Williams; thence along Williams line S. 82-55 E. 1142.3 feet to a stone and iron pin; thence S. 20-10 W. 502 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 8-35 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 6-10 E. 96.3 feet to a pike in South Carolina Highway No. 11; thence down said highway N. 85-02 W. 200 feet to a spike; thence S. 83-58 W. 200 feet to a spike; thence S. 70-48 W. 200 feet to a spike; thence S. 53-09 W. 159 feet to the point of beginning and according to said plat contains 17.70 acres, more or less.
LESS, however, that 10.87 acre tract heretofore conveyed to Curtis B. Hollifield, Jr. as is shown in Deed Book 935, Page 490.
