1. In accordance with the request of the Secretary of War, under date of December 2, 1918, (copy of which is hereto attached) YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to

ABANDON THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS ON
CAMP SEVIER, SOUTH CAROLINA.

- 2512-4, Construction of roads.
- 2512-26, 1350' of concrete road, 18' wide, from Bakery at Camp Sevier, S.C., to National Highway.
- 2512-30, Sludge Drying Beds in connection with sewage disposal plants.

It is the policy of the War Department to abandon all tent camps as soon as possible. No further improvements will be made at tent camps, other than those necessary for the health and care of the garrisons now quartered there or to be sent there for demobilization.

Work on this project must be stopped immediately, as otherwise any further expenditures made in furthering the construction or completion, other than those necessary to prevent damage to Government property or to prevent other losses to the Government, would be wasteful and are prohibited.

2. Clearance has been granted for the abandonment of the above projects.
