

Dave Burns Deed TO J.D. Woodside

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA,

COUNTY OF Greenville

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Dave Burns of the City and County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Fifty-five hundred and fifty-nine and 60/100 Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.D. Woodside of Greenville, S.C. (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J.D. Woodside, his heirs and assigns forever, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being on the Laurens Road in Greenville County, South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a locust pin on the Laurens Road, and running; thence S. 53 W. 5.48 to Locust pin; thence S. 26-7/8 W. 7.96 to iron pin; thence crossing the road ten feet wide to an iron pin; thence N. 26-7/8 E. 7.96 to an iron pin; thence N. 7-1/4 W. 3.38 to iron pin; thence N. 64-1/4 E. 4.12 to iron pin on Laurens Road; thence with the Laurens Road S. 34-1/4 E. 2.33 to the beginning corner, containing 1-44/100 acres, more or less, as shown on plat made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor, on May 12th, 1910. This includes a lot on the West side of the Laurens Road and a road ten feet wide leading from this lot to the tract of land hereinafter described Also all that other certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining the above tract and near the Laurens Road, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on corner of McAlister & Beattie's land and running; thence with their line S. 31-1/4 W. 27-3/100 chs. to iron pin; thence S. 49-1/2 E. 4.90 to iron pin; thence S. 1-1/2 E. 3.60 to iron pin; thence S. 58-3/4 E. 13.38 to iron pin; thence N. 31-1/4 E. 29.84 to an iron pin; thence N. 49-1/2 W. 11.50 chs. to iron pin on road ten feet wide; thence crossing said road to an iron pin; thence N. 63-3/4 W. 8.85 to the beginning corner, containing 60-1/3 acres, more or less, as shown on plat made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor on May 12th, 1910.

Both of the above described tracts are a part of the same land conveyed to me by J.B. Earle and J.D. Gilreath by deed dated March 9th, 1905 and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Volume "NNN" page 737.
