KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Jane C. Fowler, L.D. Fowler, H.F. Fowler and Leila Fowler & H.P. Fowler
for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred sixty-six and 37/100 Dollars,
to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

Mrs. N.V. Snow, in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs. N.V. Snow, all of our interests, claims, titles and inheritance of all kinds whatsoever,
We may own and have to an in all that tract of land containing eighty acres, more or less, situated in State and County aforesaid and on the waters of Enoree River and Peters Creek, having the following courses and distances, to wit:

Beginning at a mulberry on Kilgore line and; thence S. 87-3/4 E. 10.80 to stone; thence N. 51 E. 4.00 to white oak on Georgia Road; thence S. 44-3/4 E. 3.50 to stone; thence S. 72-1/2 E. 8.25 to stone on Peters Creek; thence N. 43 E. 20.00 to Birch on Enoree River; thence up said River to a maple; thence on J. Thad Stewarts line N. 70 E. 32.20 to a poplar on J.S. Kilgores line; thence S. 20-3/4 E. 1.00 to chestnut on Peters Creek; thence on Kilgore line S. 19-1/2 E. 14-1/2 chains to the beginning mulberry.
