

H.W. Marks DEED TO Cleveland & Williams

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, H.W. Marks, of the City and County

of Greenville

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of One thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Cleveland & Williams, a corporation of the State of South Carolina, and having its principal place of business in Greenville, South Carolina (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Cleveland & Williams, all that certain, piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid and being designated as Lot No. 3, Block A. on sub-division of J.M. Fortner, known as Summitt View, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a point on New Cut Road common to lot No. 4, and running; thence along line of Lot No. 4, 100 feet to stake; thence in a Northeasterly direction 72 feet to a point on Creole Street; thence along Creole Street S. 58-35 E. 50 feet to stake on corner of lot No. 2; thence along line of lot No. 2, 50 feet to stake; thence in a Southerly direction along line of lot No. 2, about 85 feet to stake on New Cut Road, thence along New Cut Road S. 74-55 W. 50 feet to beginning point. xxx and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
