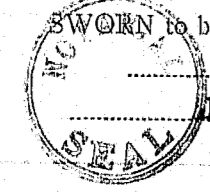

office of R.M.C. for State and County aforesaid, Vol. S.S.S. page 666.

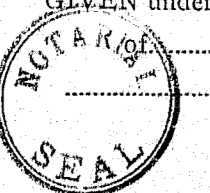
