is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
W.T. Henderson, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in
the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in the Third Ward of the City of
Greenville, having the following meets and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of South Main Street, sixty-five (65) feet and
seven (7) inches Southward from the South-west corner of Main and Broad Streets, and
running; thence along said South Main Street S. 22-1/2 W. fifty-two (52) feet to an iron
pin on the west side of South Main Street; thence N. 67-1/2 W. one hundred (100) feet along
line of Mrs. Sarah R. Davison's lot to an iron pin on a twelve foot alley; thence along
