One grave was paid for by Mr. Tobias the sum of \$15.00 being received for same.

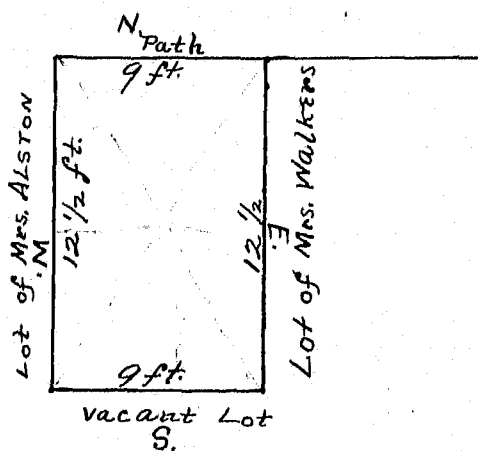
This grave & amount paid is included in this deed.

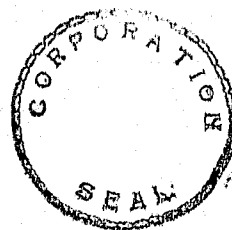
