Bates, his heirs and assigns forever all my undivided one-half (1/2) interest of in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, lying, being and situate in County and State aforesaid Bates Township, containing forty-eight and three-fourths (48-3/4) acres, more or less, bounded by lands of Virge Hellams, William Childs, Lot No. 2 and Old White Horse Road, known as tract No. 1 in Plat of the survey of the lands of John Timmons, deceased, made by W.A. Hester, Surveyor, bearing date Nov. 7th. 1906, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
