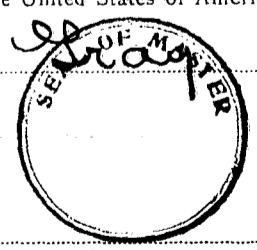
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Camilla Zooper - All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Greenville County in South Carolina, beginning at a stone in the center of the Eastley Bridge on Journees road, running thence with said road S. 52 W. 1. 79 to an iron pin in the center of road; thence S. 87 1/2 E. 1. 90 to stone; thence N. 25 1/2 W. 1. 29 to the beginning corner, containing one-ninth (1/9) of one acre, more or less, bounded by lands of N. H. Harris, Mrs. Camilla Zooper, and others, and more particularly described on plat attached to this complaint and made a part hereof.
