Mrs. Sally C. Williman (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Sally C. Williman, and to her heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the corporate limits of the City of Greenville in Ward 5, (West-end) and in the County and State aforesaid:
