 to Luther Dogan by the Mountain City Land and Improvement Co., on the 28th, day of August

 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
 J.F. Adams, All that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the
 County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, near Wood's crossing, about two and a half
 miles east of Greenville City, in Butler Township, about two or three hundred yards from the
