

May M. Bigham. DEED TO J.W. Norwood

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, May M. Bigham of the County of Greenville, and

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred and seventy-eight DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

J.W. Norwood, of the State and County aforesaid (the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J.W. Norwood, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid and within the corporate limits of the Town of Greer:

Beginning at an iron pin on Mulberry Street at Franklin Mill corner and runs; thence with Franklin Mill line Westward one hundred and fifty-five feet to an iron pin; thence northward sixty-five feet to an iron pin; thence Eastward one hundred and fifty-five feet to said Mulberry Street; thence with said Street, southward sixty-five feet to the beginning corner, the said lot being on the west side of said Mulberry Street and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by W.J. Foster by deed bearing date the 2nd, day February, 1911 and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County in Book 11, page 118.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said

J.W. Norwood, his heirs and assigns, forever.

forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said J.W. Norwood, his

heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
