 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released (the receipt whereof  
 and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

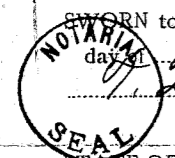
J. C. Milford, his Heirs and Assigns, All that lot of  
 land situate on the west side of Augusta Street in the  
 City and County of Greenville, S. C. beginning at a point  
 at the property line which is the Western line of the side  
 walk on said street, where said Western sidewalk line  
 intersects with line of S. A. Burt, and then running along  
 line of S. A. Burt and a continuation of same, thence  
 to a point 200 ft from the aforesaid property lines thence  
 in a line parallel with Augusta Street in a northerly  
 direction 72 ft, thence in a straight line 200 ft to a  
 point on said property line, and Western sidewalk line  
 72 ft from the beginning corner, thence in a southerly
