KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Susan White, of Greenville County
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Fifteen hundred no/100 DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by C.C. White (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

C.C. White, all that piece, parcel or tract of land situated in the County and State aforesaid on Laurel Creek, waters of Reedy River, containing sixty-seven acres, more or less and known as part of the estate of Stephen Griffith, deceased and designated as tract No. 4; on a plat made by W.A. Hudson Oct. 7th, 1899. Beginning at a stone 3X corner T.Q. Donaldson land, thence N. 4 E. 20.90, thence N. 82 W. 3.50, thence N. 11-1/4 W. 24.80 to stone 3X; thence N. 72 W. 9.70 to stone, thence S. 1-1/2 E. 50.50 to stone 3X; thence N. 84-1/2 E. 15.20 to the beginning corner. see deed given me by E. R. Taylor the 25th, day of Sept. 1901, recorded in Vol. I.I.I. page 229.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said C.C. White, his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
