KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Realty Corporation

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred and forty-three & 43/100 DOLLARS,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee... hereinafter named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto

W.D. Parrish, All those two certain lots of land situate on the North side of the National Highway and the West side of Mooney Road, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in sub-division known as Paris, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a stake on Northwestern corner of the National Highway and Mooney Road, and running thence with Mooney Road N. 37-23 W. 121 feet to a stake at bend in said Road; thence still with said Road N. 32-42 W. 127-2 feet to stake at corner of said Road and a ten foot Street which runs parallel with and adjoining the right-of-way of the Piedmont & Northern Railway Company; thence with said ten foot street S. 70-28 W. 97 feet to a stake; thence S. 30-42 E. 144.8 feet to a stake; thence S. 36-43 E. 135 feet to a stake on the National Highway; thence with said National Highway N. 53-40 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
